Adopt an Inmate

GOD IS A God of second chances. HE IS THE MAS-TER OF TAKING SOMEONE'S MESS AND TURNING IT INTO SOMETHING BEAUTIFUL. Paul is a good example of this. After his marriage fell apart, he walked away from God. He began hanging out with a backslidden friend, doing things that landed him in jail. Paul was lost and hurting, but God never gave up on him.

While in prison, Paul rededicated his life to Lord and enrolled in Rhema Correspondence Bible School. Although he is illiterate, he could supernaturally read the Bible and the books he received from RCBS. He devoured each lesson. The knowledge Paul gained from studying the Word and hearing the message of faith changed his outlook on life and gave him a future and a hope.

Today, Paul is a free man—both spiritually and naturally. He regularly ministers to the homeless and those who have been released from prison. "I remind them that we have all fallen short of the Lord, but through repentance and redemption we are forgiven," he says.

Paul is grateful that RCBS helped him to become grounded in the Word, and as a result, his relationship with God has grown. "Not only did [RCBS] feed my spirit," shares Paul, "it gave me something my ego needed—a Certificate of Accomplishment. IT GAVE ME THE FEELING I COULD AMOUNT TO SOMETHING. It has kept me afloat during some very tough times. [RCBS] was my island in a very stormy sea."



WHO WE REALLY ARE LYNETTE HAGIN

What image do you see when you look in a mirror? I'm not referring to your natural features, but who you are on the inside. If we're going to be all that God has called us to be, we have to look into the mirror of our life. We must take our masks off and see ourselves for who we really are. MIRRORS DON'T HIDE ANYTHING;

THEY SHOW EVERYTHING. The mirror of our life reveals our thoughts, actions, intents, and agendas. It's important that we can see what needs to be changed in our hearts.

In First Samuel chapter 16, God told Samuel to go to Jesse's house and anoint one of his sons to be king. Jesse bought his oldest son who was tall, handsome, and fit. Samuel thought, "Surely, this is the one!" "But the Lord said to Samuel, 'Don't judge by his appearance or height, for I have rejected him.

The Lord doesn't see things the way you see them. People judge by outward appearance, but

the Lord looks at the heart' " (1 Sam. 16:7 NLT). Seven of Jesse's sons passed before Samuel. Each time, God said no.

Jesse sent for his youngest son. When David arrived, the Lord said, *"This is the one; anoint him"* (1 Sam. 16:12 NLT). David was a man after God's heart (Acts 13:22). He was quick to do everything God asked. CAN WE SAY WE ARE WOMEN AFTER GOD'S HEART?

THE UNEDITED YOU DENISE HAGIN BURNS

WE EDIT OURSELVES CONSTANTLY. It's in our culture to put the

best out there. While everyone on social media is #livingmybestlife, we compare our real life with their "best life." Then we feel bad about our lives and feel the pressure to edit.

WHEN WE EDIT OUR-SELVES, WE'RE NO LONGER WHO WE REALLY ARE. We hide our feelings and thoughts. We put on the smile. Here's the tension: the more we edit, the more isolated and lonely we become. No one knows who we really are.

Receive What You Need

CRAIG W. HAGIN

YEARS AGO I broke my leg while riding my dirt bike. My dad told me, "Son, if I could take your place, I would." He didn't like seeing me in pain. If you are a parent or grandparent, you know it hurts to watch your child or grandchild suffer. YOU'LL DO ANYTHING YOU CAN TO REMOVE THE SUFFERING.

Think about this as we look at Jairus in Luke chapter 8. His daughter was dying, and he came to Jesus for help. Imagine how excited Jairus was when Jesus said He would come to his home! Scripture records, "As [Jesus] went, the multitudes thronged Him" (Luke 8:42 NKJV).

That's when the woman with a blood disease touched the hem of Jesus' garment and was healed. Jairus just witnessed a great miracle and then received the worst news: "Your daughter is dead" (v. 49 NKJV). He went from elation to loss. We can imagine how he felt. Jesus heard what was said and responded, "Do not be afraid; only believe, and she will be made well" (v. 50 NKJV).

Maybe we're not in situations where someone is dying, but how many of us are trusting God, and it seems like everybody else is getting their needs met? Instead of our situation getting better, it got worse.

In looking at Jairus' situation, we see three steps that Jesus gave him. We can follow those same steps today and get results.

1 Do Not Be Afraid

When we hear bad news, fearful thoughts are going to come. But it's never okay to dwell on those thoughts. Understand that when we say, "I'm afraid," we are speaking contrary to the Word of God. The Bible says that God has not given us a spirit of fear but of power, love, and a sound mind (2 Tim. 1:7). What we should do is cast down fear-filled thoughts (2 Cor. 10:5) by saying, "God has not given me a spirit of fear. I am not going to be afraid."

FEAR IS THE OPPOSITE OF FAITH. When we are afraid of something, we are not in faith. We will have plenty of opportunities to be frightened, but sometimes we have to eradicate fear from our lives. We need to quit trying to figure things out, and let God do it! If Jairus had become afraid or disappointed by what was said, he would have stepped out of faith. We can never let fear motivate us.

2 Only Believe

Jesus didn't give Jairus a choice! He told him to believe—*only* believe. What do we believe? That God met all our needs when Jesus died on the cross. When He said, "It is finished," He was talking about our issues, our problems, and our situations. We just need to claim what we need today.

Some people believe that God *can* heal but think they're not good enough for Him to heal them. We can't discount ourselves! Jesus didn't come for worthy people. He came for all people. He made

us worthy. For those who aren't Christians, the Bible says that Jesus stands at the door of their hearts and knocks (Rev. 3:20), waiting for them to respond. It's not about what we have done. It's about how much God loves us. NOTHING CAN SEPA-RATE US FROM HIS LOVE.

3 See Your Needs Met

When we get out of fear and only believe, our needs will be met. It will happen. (Read what happened for Jairus in Luke 8:51–56.) We can't *make* anything happen. But we can believe and *let* it happen. **GOD WANTS TO MEET OUR NEEDS.** We have the easy part, and that is to believe. It's all about trusting God.

When things look as though they are getting worse, we can't let that sway us. Jesus said, **"ONLY BELIEVE."** He didn't give a time frame, so keep believing! It's incredible what He can do—more than we can ask or think! Remember that God loves us. He's always for us and never against us. Kick out unbelief! Resist fear! Let Him move, and we will receive what we need.














IN THE OLD TESTAMENT, the common layman—we would call him a believer today—had no anointing *in* or *on* him. The presence of God was kept shut up in the Holy of Holies in the Temple. God, however, anointed the king, priest, and prophet to stand in their respective offices. The Spirit of God came *upon* them to enable them to fulfill what they were called to do.

Anointings Today

God is still anointing *prophets* today. Under the Old Covenant, the prophet gave guidance to the people because they didn't have the Holy Spirit. Today, believers have the Holy Spirit to lead and guide them. The primary ministry of the New Testament prophet is to preach or teach the Word. Prophesying is not the main thrust of the prophet's ministry.

God is still anointing *priests*. In the Old Testament, the function of the priest was to represent the people. Only the High Priest was permitted to enter the Holy of Holies where the presence of God was. He was the *intercessor* for the Israelites. God is anointing intercessors today. He is anointing people to pray.

God is still anointing *kings*. We are all kings. Romans 5:17 says that we shall *"reign in life."* It's because of the anointing that we are able to reign. And it's by the Spirit of God that victories come, not by the hand of man.

ISAIAH 10:27

27 And it shall come to pass in that day, that his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke

from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.

Sometimes we turn that phrase around and say, "It's the anointing that destroys (or breaks) the yoke. This is true in our lives: The yoke of sickness or anything the devil tries to put on us is destroyed because of the anointing.

In the Gospels, we see how the anointing was on Jesus. We can learn about ministering under the anointing by studying His life.

LUKE 4:14-19

14 And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.

15 And he taught in their synagogues, being glorified of all.16 And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

17 And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written,

18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

19 To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

We see in verse 18 that God anointed Jesus primarily to do two things—to preach and heal. In connection with preaching, Jesus was also anointed to teach.

The Ministry of Jesus

When discussing the earthly ministry of Jesus, most people immediately respond, "He was the Son of God." Of course, He was. They fail to realize that as the Son of God, Jesus was one thing. But as a person ministering, He was another thing.

Jesus was just as much the Son of God at age 21 as He was when He was 30 years old. Yet, until He was 30, He never healed anyone or wrought a miracle. Jesus did not minister as the Son of God—He ministered as a mere man anointed by the Holy Spirit.

If people thought for a moment, they would see this from Luke 4. Jesus was in His hometown of Nazareth. He went to the synagogue and was given the scroll of Isaiah to read from. He began, "*The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me*" (v. 18). After He had finished reading the passage of scripture, Jesus sat down, and everyone in the synagogue looked at Him. He then said, "*This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears*" (Luke 4:21).

If Jesus had ministered as the Son of God, He would not have needed to be anointed. Or if He had ministered as God manifested in the flesh, would God have needed to be anointed? Who can anoint God?

Philippians 2:7 (TLB and AMPC) tells us that Jesus "laid aside" or "stripped Himself" of His mighty power and glory when He came into this world. He came as a man. Although in person He was the Son of God, in power He was not the Son of God.

When people say that Jesus ministered on the earth as the Son of God, they put Him *in ministry* in a class by Himself. That would mean that nobody else could minister in the same way, or even come close to it.

As a person, because Jesus is the Son of God, He is in a class by Himself. But in ministry, He is not. Why? Remember what Jesus said in John 14:12, "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father."

JESUS DID NOT MINISTER AS THE SON OF GOD—HE MINISTERED AS A MERE MAN **anointed by the Holy Spirit**.

If the miracles and healings Jesus did were in a class by themselves, He told a falsehood. But He told us in the above verse that not only could we do what He did but also greater works. We've been religiously brainwashed to think that because Jesus is the Son of God, we couldn't possibly minister like Him. But that is not true.

Jesus in the Fivefold Ministry

Jesus stood in all of the fivefold ministries listed in Ephesians 4:11—apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor, and teacher. An anointing goes with each of these offices. If you function in your office, the anointing will be there. It can become stronger—it can be increased—or you can cause it to diminish and decrease. In John 3:34, John the Baptist, speaking about Jesus, infers that He had the Holy Spirit *without measure*, inferring that we have the Spirit *by measure*.

There is a measure of the Holy Spirit *in* the believer for a certain purpose, but an anointing *comes upon* you to stand in the office—or ministry—to which God has called you.

Because Jesus had the Holy Spirit without measure, He stood in all five of the ministry gifts, and He is the model for us to follow. \checkmark





From Death to Life



KENNETH E. HAGIN

WHEN ADAM SINNED in the Garden of Eden, he became separated from God. At that moment, humanity also became separated from God.

Adam was driven from the Garden with no legal ground to approach God. He could no longer respond to the call of God, only to his new nature and new master.

MANKIND BECAME LAWBREAKERS AND SINNERS. Spiritually, we became children of the devil and partakers of his nature. This explains why conduct can't save us. Right behavior does not change the sin nature every person is born with. We have to be born again.

No one can stand in the Presence of God as they are because of the sin nature. For anyone to escape the penalty of sin, they have to be saved by someone who can pay that penalty and give them a new nature.

Since we are a spirit being that lives in a body, our nature can change. **WE CAN BECOME A NEW CREATURE IN CHRIST JESUS!** It doesn't matter how many degrees we obtain, how much money we accumulate, or how religious we are. On our own, we don't have any merit to stand in the Presence of God. We are lost; not because of what we have done, but because of the sin nature we inherited. Without Jesus, we are spiritually dead. But thanks to God, Christ has redeemed us from spiritual death! Jesus did not have any sin in Him. He was not conceived the way we were, so He didn't have the spiritual nature of the devil in Him.

Jesus paid sin's penalty on the cross. He took upon Himself our sin nature so we might have eternal life (Heb. 9:26). Jesus said, "*I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life*" (John 5:24).

THE NEW BIRTH DOES NOT TAKE PLACE GRADUALLY. IT IS INSTANTANEOUS! We receive this gift the moment we believe. We just have to admit our helplessness and hopelessness. We have to admit that we are what the Bible says—lost sinners. Then we can accept what Christ did for us.

Have you passed from spiritual death to spiritual life? Is God your Father? Is His Spirit within your spirit confirming that you are a child of God? If you are not born again, accept Christ as your Savior today!


Receive Jesus as Your Lord and Savior



CHRISTMAS IS a season of gift giving and beautiful decorations. Angels are a holiday adornment we see on everything—from Christmas trees to holiday cards. But what do they represent? What do *real* angels *really* do?

Throughout the Bible, we see angels doing mighty things for God's people. That supernatural activity is still happening today! Our lives should be filled with supernatural happenings with angels playing a significant role. We need to pay more

attention to them and be sensitive to their activity. Angels are doing far more for us than we realize!

God's Supernatural Agents

Angels watch over us. I call them God's supernatural agents. Hebrews 1:14 (NIV) reveals them as ministering spirits who are sent to serve us. They protect us, carry out assignments, and bring messages from God. Throughout the Bible, they appeared in human form.

Hebrews 13:2 (NKJV) says, "Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some have unwittingly entertained angels." Some people want to worship angels. But we're not to worship them (Rev. 22:8–9) or seek visitations. My dad used to say that if we pray for angelic visitations, the devil might accommodate us (2 Cor. 11:14). Jesus is the One we worship.

Hebrews 1:1–14 shows us how much greater Jesus is than angels and that they were created to worship Him. It concludes by explaining the proper place of angels in our lives: "*Therefore, angels are only servants—spirits sent to care for people who will inherit salvation*" (v. 14 NLT). Angels were made to follow the commands that God gives them.

and then uttered. It's just a great book lying on the coffee table until somebody opens it up and declares, "No weapon formed against me will prosper!" (Isa. 54:17).

When we speak in agreement with God's Word, angels have the right to operate. When we talk contradictory to the Word, their hands are tied. Angels are listening to our words! When the angel visited Daniel, he said, *"I have come because of your words"* (Dan. 10:12 NKJV).

Ministering Spirits, Go!

When my dad started in the traveling ministry, we experienced hard times. He was good at exercising faith for healing, but not for money! While in prayer, the Lord ministered to Dad about finances.* After explaining that God had put the wealth and resources in the earth for His people, Jesus told Dad to do three things:

- **USE** your authority in the Name of Jesus to claim what you need.
- **2** BIND the devil and command him to take his hands off your money.
- **TELL** the ministering spirits to go and cause the finances to come.

Dad didn't have trouble with the first two because he already knew about authority in Jesus' Name and binding the devil. But he had a little difficulty with ministering spirits because he had never been taught about angels. Yet he began to do it, and things changed.

These three steps aren't limited to finances. We can do this with anything. We've learned faith and confession. But many of us aren't putting our angels into operation. We hear of people binding things all the time. But if we're going to bind, then send the ministering spirits out to help!

Allow Angels to Minister

My dad's book *I Believe in Visions* covers the angelic visitations he had. In it, you'll find that one time God sent an angel to Dad, but he didn't respond. (See chapter 6, "The Angel's Visit.")

We need to be more conscious that ministering spirits are around us all the time. It will help raise our expectations of what God can do for us in our current situations! Perhaps, we then can yield to angels in a way that allows them to minister to us!

Psalm 34:7 (NLT) says, "*The angel of the Lord is a guard; he surrounds and defends all who fear him.*" The word *fear* means "being in awe." It appears that angels are always guarding, but this verse implies that they are only watching over those who worship Him in awe.

We all need to realize that we have angels who are ready to minister for us! Wherever we are, angels are listening to our words, waiting to carry out God's Word spoken by us.♥

There are multiple incidents in the Word of God of angelic activity in the life of Jesus. The angel Gabriel announced the birth of Jesus to Mary (Luke 1:26–38). Joseph was instructed by an angel to take Mary home as his wife (Matt. 1:18–25 NIV). Jesus' birth was announced by angels to the shepherds (Luke 2:8–15). Joseph was warned by the angel of the Lord in a dream to escape to Egypt and was later told when it was safe to return. (Matt. 2:13, 19–20).

When Jesus ended His 40-day fast, "angels came and ministered to Him" (Matt. 4:11 NKJV). In the Garden of Gethsemane, angels strengthened Him (Luke 22:43). Angels rolled back the stone from Jesus' tomb (Matt. 28:2–8). When He ascended into Heaven, two angels told those who were watching that Jesus would be coming back (Acts 1:9–11).

CHRISTMAS TRADITIONS

DECEMBER IS A busy month. Most people spend the month going to various Christmas parties, decorating their Christmas tree, shopping for gifts, and preparing for a special Christmas dinner. In the midst of all the celebrations, it is easy to forget the reason for the season.

Christmas is really about a big present God gave the world over 2,000 years ago—Jesus! A wellknown verse in the Bible and probably the first one you memorized is John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

I still become emotional when I read that verse. Even though humanity messed up, God loved His creation so much that He sent His best gift—His Son Jesus—to redeem us from our fallen state. I am grateful for that gift, and it is important to remind our families of it.

Many families have traditions they observe at Christmastime. Many years ago, my husband and I established the traditions we celebrate.

On Christmas Eve, we attend the *Carols, Candlelight & Communion* service at Rhema Bible Church. Afterward, our family gets together for dinner where we eat my famous Chicken and Dumplings. The entire family loves them, but it can be a miracle to find one item that everyone agrees on!

Before we open the gifts, my husband reminds our family of God's goodness. He tells us that God should be the most important person in our lives, and it is because of the Lord's provision we can give gifts. Then we pray for families that are experiencing difficulties during this time.

As I was meditating on what the Lord would have me write this month, the words "Jehovah Jireh, God our Provider," came to me. As I said previously, God provided a way for our salvation through the blood of Jesus. But God's provisions go beyond that.

The Christmas season brings considerable financial pressure that every family experiences. Parents want to give their children the special gift they have been asking for. It can be a cause of concern, worry, and frustration as parents wonder where the finances will come from.

This is when we need to go to the promises of God. I trust the following passage will be of comfort to you.

"Then, turning to his disciples, Jesus said, 'That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life—whether you have enough food to eat or enough clothes to wear. For life is more than food, and your body more than clothing. Look at the ravens. They don't plant or harvest or store food in barns, for God feeds them. And you are far more valuable to him than any birds! Can all your worries add a single moment to your life? And if worry can't accomplish a little thing like that, what's the use of worrying over bigger things? " 'Look at the lilies and how they grow. They don't work or make their clothing, yet Solomon in all his glory was not dressed as

beautifully as they are. And if God cares so wonderfully for flowers that are here today and thrown into the fire tomorrow, he will certainly care for you. Why do you have so little faith? And don't be concerned about what to eat and what to drink. Don't worry about such things. These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers all over the world, but your Father already knows your needs. Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and he will give you everything you need'" (Luke 12:22–31 NLT).

I encourage you to trust God for the financial supply you need for this Christmas season. It may come in various ways—through a raise or bonus or through other methods. I always ask God to direct me to where the items I need are on sale. Don't limit God on how He provides.

Trust Him as the Apostle Paul declared in Philippians 4:19 (NLT) "And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus."

Have a Merry Christmas, and remember to celebrate the greatest event, the birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ!




