The Open Door of Healing



JESUS HAS ALREADY
opened doors of blessing for

His people. He not only opened the door of salvation, but He also opened the door of healing. Jesus opened this door, and no man can shut it.

Isaiah prophesied that the coming Messiah would bear the sicknesses and diseases of us all. When he spoke, he was looking into the future.

ISAIAH 53:4-5

4 Surely he hath borne our griefs [sicknesses], and carried our sorrows [diseases]: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and **with his stripes we are healed.**

Isaiah was prophesying about Jesus offering Himself as a sacrifice for our sins and bearing our sicknesses and diseases.

When Peter wrote of the covenant of healing, he was looking back in time to Jesus' sacrifice at Calvary and to the stripes that were laid on His back.

1 PETER 2:24

24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: **by whose stripes ye were healed.**

Notice this verse doesn't say we are *going to be* healed—future tense. It says we were healed—past tense. That means

in the mind of God we were healed at the cross of Calvary when our sins and sicknesses were laid on Jesus.

The door of healing and health is wide open. Jesus opened it, but it's up to you to go through it! Someone asked, "How do you pass through the door of healing?" You go through it by faith in what God said in His Word!

How did Jesus open the door of healing for mankind? By sacrificing Himself! Matthew 8:17 says, "*Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.*" That open door of healing is waiting for us to go through it. Healing belongs to us *now*!

We passed through the door of salvation by accepting Jesus as Savior. We pass through the door of healing the same way—by accepting Jesus as Healer. We accept Jesus as Savior and Healer by faith in what God said in His Word.

Physical healing is part and parcel of the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

God Provided Forgiveness and Healing

The psalmist said that God provided both forgiveness and healing. Both of these doors are open to us.

PSALM 103:2-3

2 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:

3 Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases.

God not only forgives all our sins, but He also heals all our diseases. If we need

healing, we can appropriate what Jesus has already provided for us. What is even better is to walk in sweet fellowship with Jesus so we can walk in healing and health.

Enter the Door for Yourself

You must enter the door of healing for yourself. Others can inspire your faith so you go through that door. But no one can enter it for you. This is especially true concerning healing, but it also applies to any other door of provision Jesus opens for you.

Once, a young lady was injured in an automobile accident and broke her neck and back in two places. The doctor said she would never walk again. After two years in the hospital and extensive physical therapy, she could finally swing her body along between crutches for 10 to 12 feet at a time.

At age 28, she came to one of my meetings. She eventually asked me, “Who’s going to have faith for my healing—me or you?”

“Both of us,” I said. “I have to have faith to lay hands on you for your healing. And you have to have faith to receive your healing.”

“Well,” she said, “if I’m supposed to believe anything, just forget it.” She never came back to any more of those meetings.

Two years later, I was holding a series of meetings in the same church. That young woman attended day and night, listening. On Friday night of the second week, she came forward and stood in the healing line. She said, “I’ve come for healing. Just lay your hands on me.”

What a vast difference! Before, she was trying to get me to carry her on my faith. Now she was ready to enter the door of healing herself!

I reached my hand out and barely brushed her forehead. She raised both hands and began to praise God for her healing. Both of her crutches fell away, and she walked off totally healed!

Whatever God has provided for you—salvation, healing, provision, and so forth—you have to enter through the door.

We can help one another. For example, another believer can come into agreement with you in prayer for your healing. Others can join their faith with yours. They can help to inspire your faith. But they can’t go through the door for you. Neither can Jesus Himself. He said, “*Behold, I have set before thee an open*

door” (Rev. 3:8).

Jesus was saying, “I’ve done My part. I’ve already paid the price, and I’ve opened the door for you. Now it’s up to you to go through it.” In the same verse, He added, “No man can shut that door on you.”

You Can Shut the Door

We recognize that Jesus is the One who opens and shuts doors. But when we do not enter an open door, we are, in effect shutting the door to that blessing.

You can shut the door of healing on yourself. One way you can forfeit your rights to what belongs to you in Christ is by wrong living and wrongdoing.

Today, it seems we live in a promiscuous society where immorality is accepted. Failure to judge sin and wrongdoing can eventually result in believers being turned over to the devil (see 1 Cor. 5:1–5). They will forfeit their right to the blessings of God that belong to them.

When we don’t judge ourselves, we open ourselves up to the Lord’s judgment by our own sin and disobedience.

When you don’t enter through Jesus’ open door because of sin, you are shutting doors on yourself. You are closing yourself off from God’s wonderful doors of blessing, provision, and promise.

Jesus works on your behalf to open doors for you. Don’t close yourself off from those doors. Trust the Holy Spirit to help you see and recognize them.

By faith and obedience, walk through each door and receive what God has so bountifully provided for you. Let your life be a testimony to the riches of God’s inheritance in Christ. ♥

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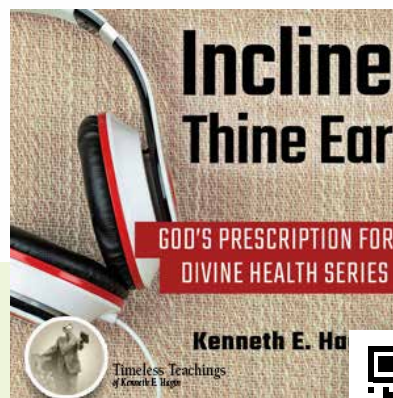
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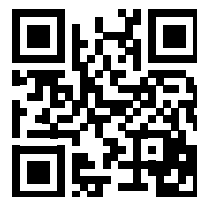


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The Power of Words

“What do you have to say about yourself?” In John 1:19–23 (NLT), John the Baptist answered that question clearly: *“I am a voice shouting. . . Clear the way for the Lord’s coming!”*

I’m asking you the same question.

WHAT DO YOU SAY ABOUT YOURSELF?

If we don’t recognize we’re designed by God and have value to Him, we’ll have difficulty saying what He says about us. We’ve been bought with a price. So, the things we say about ourselves matter.

Mark 11:23 (NKJV) says, *“Whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his*

power to build people up or tear them down. If our words can move mountains, they can also build stumbling blocks and brick walls in our lives.

WHEN WORDS STAY WITH YOU

When I was little, I got the idea that a lie would get me out of trouble. My dad said one time in anger, “Son, if you don’t stop lying, nobody will ever believe a word you say.”

Years later, I was born again. I applied for a job as a police officer, which required me to take a lie detector test. I passed. But the examiner mentioned one topic that raised the needle. I said, “When you asked me to rate myself on honesty,

So we must choose to speak life-filled words. Let’s choose to speak life to other people. It’s not enough to believe the best in people. We have to tell them we believe the best in them.

Instead of agreeing with someone who says, “I doubt I’ll get through this,” tell them, “I’m believing God that you will. With God’s help, you’ll do amazing things.”

Likewise, when it comes to ourselves, we have a choice. We can say what our situation looks like. We can say what it feels like. Or we can say what God says about it.

DECLARE WHAT GOD SAYS

You might be ready to give up, but God says, *“Let the weak say, I am strong”* (Joel 3:10 NKJV). You might have gotten the worst report of your life, but the Bible says, *“He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses”* (Matthew 8:17 NKJV).

Somebody might say, “I call it like I see it.” That’s the problem. What if you called it like God sees it?

God sees you as a winner. He says you’re going to make it through. But you have to see what God sees and say what He says about you. ♥

SAY THIS:

I choose to say what God says about it. I will stay with the Word. I boldly confess that I walk in God’s favor. Jesus said with my words, I can move every mountain. And that’s why I’m rejoicing and shouting.

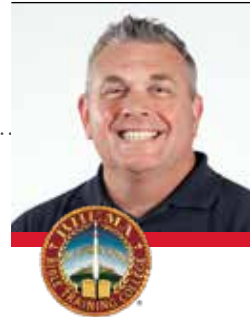
We must choose our words carefully because they have the

Don't Rush the Moment

Wait on God!

Being still before the Lord is an intentional positioning
that requires discipline.

WE LIVE IN a generation of speed. We want everything quick. But that's not how God lives. God does not live for speed—He lives for relationship.

GOD'S PACE IS RELATIONSHIP.

In order to have a relationship with God, you have to spend time with Him. You can't rush it. You can't fast-food it. You have to sit down at His table and eat a five-course meal.

We can't rush the moment! Sometimes we want to microwave it, but we have to realize that you can't microwave spiritual depth. It's cultivated over time.

In Psalm 46:10, God says, *"Be still, and know that I am God"* (NLT). Being still is hard for us in this day and age. If

the scripture had said, "Be busy and know," we would all be fine. If it had said, "Be productive and know that I am God," we type-A people would have it on our list, checking it off every day. We're productive, but are we being still and knowing God, or are we just rushing through the moment?

Often, we interpret stillness and rest as inactivity or unproductive time, but that simply isn't the case. Being still before the Lord is an intentional positioning that requires discipline. It doesn't take much discipline to be busy, but it sure takes a lot of discipline to be still.

Let's look at the prophet Elijah as an example.

In First Kings 19:4, Elijah prayed: *"I have had enough, Lord,"* he said. *"Take my life, for I am no better than my*

ancestors who have already died” (NLT). Prior to that, he had won an amazing victory on Mount Carmel by calling down fire from heaven (see 1 Kings 18:16–39). And God showed up in a great display of His power. This was an amazing moment—a mountaintop experience.

Then Jezebel heard about it and vowed to kill him. When Elijah received her message, he decided to flee for his life. He didn’t take time to be still and be refilled. He was depleted, so he went on the run, away from God’s calling.

In First Kings 19, Elijah went into a cave. He was depressed and halfway suicidal, yet he was still a man of God. In that cave, he learned to wait. He learned that in the waiting, depth of relationship comes, and in that depth is where you will hear God’s voice.

The Lord asked Elijah what he was doing in the cave. He replied that people were trying to kill him. In First Kings 19:11, God told Elijah, “Go out and stand before me on the mountain” (NLT). As Elijah stood there, the Lord passed by, and a mighty windstorm hit the mountain, but God was not in the wind. After the wind came an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake.

Now, notice this. Time was passing by. It was a moment. The winds were passing by and whipping around. The earthquake came to shake everything. But God was not in all this.

Fire came after the earthquake, but the Lord was not in the fire. After the fire, there came “the sound of a gentle whisper” (1 Kings 19:12 NLT). And God was in the whisper.

I wonder how much time passed from the wind to the whisper. Sometimes you have to wait for God. It might look like He’s in this or in that, but He’s not.

When someone whispers, what do you naturally do? You lean in. You draw closer. By not rushing the moment, you lean in closer to the heart of God.

God is asking you, “Will you be patient enough from the time of the wind to the moment I actually show up in the whisper?”

DON’T RUSH THE MOMENT IN YOUR PERSONAL TIME WITH THE LORD.

In Jeremiah 29:13, God says, “If you look for me wholeheartedly, you will find me” (NLT). The word wholeheartedly has the connotation of being undivided, of putting your whole being into an action.

I love how Psalm 62:5 puts it: “Let all that I am wait quietly before God, for my hope is in him” (NLT).

Going deeper in our relationship with God requires intentional focus. Hebrews 12:1 tells us, “Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith, let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us” (NLT).

View Hebrews 12:1 through the lens of Hebrews 12:2: “We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus”—not on the cell phone, not on the news alert, not on the likes on social media during prayer. I love this verse in *The Passion Translation*: “We look away from the natural realm and we focus our attention and expectation onto Jesus.”

The enemy works so hard to distract us in the natural because going spiritually deep requires us to focus on Jesus. Keeping our eyes on Jesus requires a spiritual attention span.

If you want to go deeper into God’s presence, pray your way into it.

Don’t let spiritual ADD cause you to check out five minutes after prayer begins. When you pray for five minutes, you’re barely getting started. That’s just the warmup.

Psalm 100:4 says, “Enter his gates with thanksgiving; go into his courts with praise” (NLT). Praise is the entry point. Praise will bring you into the presence of God, but prayer will bring you to the heart of God. We need an encounter with God that is activated by prayer. I want to be in His presence, but I want to *live* at His heart. Don’t rush the moment.♥

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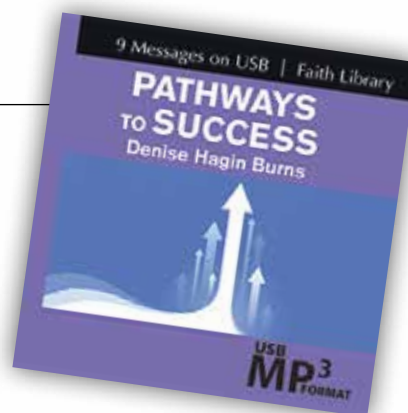

SPEAKER HIGHLIGHT

I WANT TO talk to you about bonds. Sometimes they aren't obvious, and we almost feel like we can put up with them. We let them push us down like heavy chains until we sink into the dust. But this approach just intensifies our bonds. Think about it: Who is supposed to be crawling in the dirt on his belly? Who is supposed to be eating that dust? When I was throwing a pity party one time, the Lord told me, "What are you doing down there in the dust, rolling around in your emotions? Get up!"

We are no more righteous today than we were on the first day we were saved. But bonds keep us from operating at our highest and best. These bonds, if we receive them, will handicap us. That's why we can't give the enemy a foothold (Eph. 4:27). Where is the foothold? It's in us.



All of a sudden, we become chained to a wrong identity. We start looking at others and seeing what we're not. And then we start tying a bond to the wrong identity. We're trying to identify with man, dirt, and dust. That way, we sink into Adam's fallen identity. We get

wounded. The pain is heavy, and it slowly pushes us down because we don't know what we're carrying.

What does the enemy shoot at you? The only ammunition he has is suggestion. Do you know what he gets you to do? Self-sabotage. He has no teeth, no power, no authority. It's all been stripped. But if he can get you to feel a certain way, you lose sight of who you are.

We must lay down our dignity, our pride, and who we think we are. Many people try to renew their mind, but they miss step one, which is sacrifice. That means that we must lay down the identity we're trying to hold on to.

We have to be able to say: "I've been crucified with Christ. It's no longer I who lives. It's Him who lives in me, and I like to stay up here enthroned with Him." We need to understand that the renewal of our mind is a process, and it's work. It's crazy how lazy we are. We want a fast fix. But **THERE'S THIS DEEP WORK THAT GOD WANTS TO DO WITH US.** There's restoration and transformation that take place in us when we receive all that He is into all of us and we put our lives completely in Him.

Paul says, "*Until Christ be formed in you*" (Gal. 4:19). You see, we've been putting in all the information, but is the Word living in us? When we have the Word of God living within us, the right

words will just come out of us. It's all about the Word and the Spirit. And when they come together, our lives will be changed.

Let's shake off everything that's holding us back and realize who's in us! Because there's no devil in hell that can stand against the power of God that lives on the inside of us. 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HEALING BEGINS WITH FORGIVENESS

GOD WANTS US to prosper in every way. He wants us to have a life better than we ever dreamed of. That's why Jesus gave His life. He came to redeem us. Unfortunately, some believers aren't experiencing this abundant, fruitful life. The Lord said to me, "One of the reasons why Christians are not prospering and are not in health—although they're making confession after confession—is because they are in a prison of unforgiveness."

FORGIVENESS IS A WORD WE BOTH LOVE AND HATE. It's tremendous when it's applied to us. God was so merciful to send Jesus to die for our sins. Now we're forgiven. It's as if God clicked delete on His heavenly computer. Our sins are totally removed from the hard drive—never to be remembered or held against us.

We're certainly thankful for that kind of forgiveness. But there's another facet of forgiveness that's more difficult to deal with. And that's when God asks us to exercise that same forgiving power toward others.

Mark 11:25 (NKJV) says, "*And whenever*

you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses." In other words, we must forgive everyone who has offended us or who has done us wrong. How many times must we forgive? Jesus told Peter, "*Seventy times seven*" (Matt. 18:21–22). That's 490 times for just one offense!

When somebody hurts us and does something mean, our human nature wants to retaliate. But that is our carnal nature taking over. What do we have to do? We have to let the nature of God take over. Alexander Pope wrote, "To err is human; to forgive, divine." You know, it takes the love of God in our hearts to forgive. We can't do it in the natural. Instead, we have to allow the love of God to come in and heal us. It's much easier to bear a grudge than to pardon someone, isn't it?

Let me ask you a question. When someone you thought you'd forgiven is mentioned in a conversation, what comes into your thought life? Hot embers inside of you can begin to light

a fire, and all of a sudden, you burn on the inside of you.

It's so important to deal with that, and not to ever let those embers become a fire in the first place.

A HARD PILL TO SWALLOW

I don't know about you, but when I first discovered verses on forgiveness in the Bible, it was a hard pill for me to swallow. I'm a person who loves deeply. So if someone I cared about said something bad about me, it would really hurt me. To protect myself from being hurt again, I'd write them off. I'd just put them in my "never-to-speak-to-again" file.

But when I heard my father-in-law, Kenneth E. Hagin, teaching on this subject, I knew I had to straighten up my act. I knew I had to learn to forgive.

Now, forgiveness does not mean we deny the evil that has been done to us. It doesn't mean we gloss over the pain we've suffered and excuse sinful behavior. It doesn't mean we let someone continue to abuse us. And it certainly isn't about removing all the consequences.

No! True forgiveness is about you. It's about cleansing yourself from the poison of resentment. It's about healing yourself. Forgiveness is not acting as if the sin never happened, or letting someone continually abuse you. It does not mean excusing something or pretending it didn't happen. Some people think that if you forgive someone, then you must pretend that the offense didn't happen. That's not true.

You see, bitterness will keep you from having the kind of relationship with God that you should have. It will take away your joy and can even harm you physically. Medical scientists linked the failure to forgive with all kinds of illnesses—stress, anxiety, depression, headaches, backaches, stomach distress, diabetes, hypertension, and heart problems. I've known someone who died prematurely after allowing bitterness and unforgiveness to overtake him. Don't let that happen.

Clara Barton, who founded the American Red Cross, is a good example of someone who rejected bitterness. A reporter asked her about an especially cruel thing that had been done to her years before. Ms. Barton seemed not to recall the incident and said, "I distinctly remember forgetting that incident." We also have to "distinctly remember to forget" hurtful incidents in our lives.

IT'S A CHOICE

Forgiveness is a choice—not a feeling. God never said, "Forgive them if you feel like it." We're never going to feel like it. But when we choose to forgive rather than hold a grudge or

retaliate, our lives will change. We'll find healing, restoration, and freedom that only the Lord can give.

Is there unforgiveness in your heart today? Don't let those situations continue to hurt you. Jesus has given us the key—forgiveness. And if you'll open the door of your heart and take out all of the junk you've been holding on to, He will restore you. Let the Lord heal you. Choose to forgive today. ♥

PRAY THE FOLLOWING PRAYER OUT LOUD:

Lord, I choose to forgive those who have hurt me. I choose not to hold on to resentment. I let go of my right to seek revenge, and I ask you to heal my damaged emotions. Thank You for setting me free from the bondage of bitterness. In Jesus' Name, amen.

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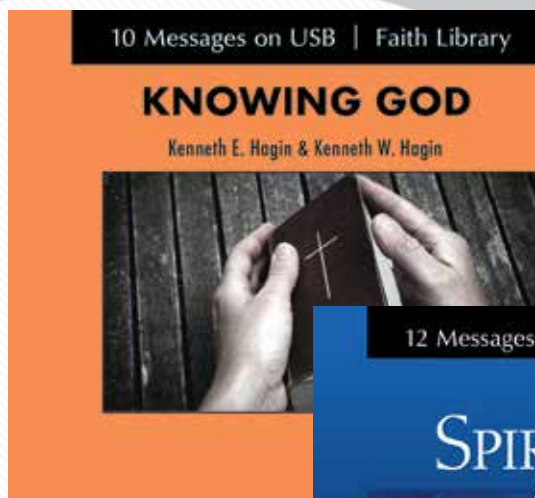
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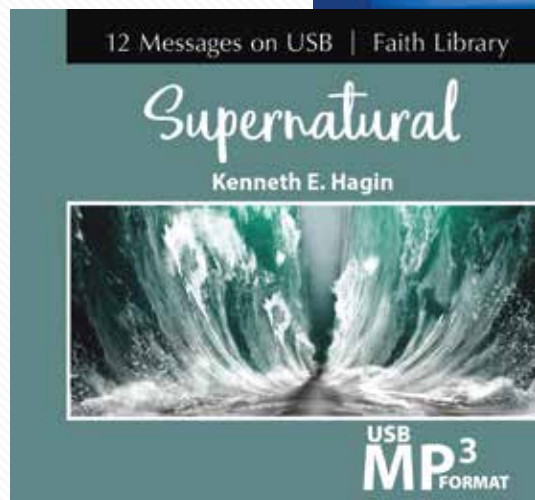


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RHEMA USA GRADUATES 52ND CLASS



RHEMA BIBLE TRAINING COLLEGE celebrated its 52nd graduation on Friday, May 15, 2026. The Rhema Bible Church Auditorium was filled with excitement, and graduates robed in red, blue, and black were ready to turn their tassels. This year, 227 students received diplomas and a symbolic relay baton—a Rhema tradition that represents the call to

take the message of faith and revival to the world.

Dean Tad Gregurich opened the ceremony by honoring the graduates' sacrifice, obedience, and preparation. He also took time to honor Dr. Kirk DuBois, who faithfully served Kenneth Hagin Ministries for 44 years. Tonight marked his final official event as he embarks on a

new chapter pursuing God's call on his life. However, he will continue to contribute to our RBTC students by teaching specific courses part-time and sharing his wisdom and experience in the classroom. Gregurich highlighted that Dr. DuBois was a fellow laborer, diligent colleague, and a vital part of this ministry, who will be missed.



THIS YEAR'S COMMENCEMENT

speaker was traveling minister and author Rev. Tony Cooke. He is a 1980 and 1981 RBTC graduate and served as RBTC dean, instructor, senior associate pastor, and National Director of the RMAI department for many years. Cooke began by emphasizing the importance of what happens after graduation. "We're excited about the years you've studied at Rhema, but we're even more excited about what is ahead of you because God has put amazing things inside of you."

He encouraged the graduates to hold on to what they've learned at Rhema, even if they don't end up on a big platform and instead serve behind the scenes. "Don't wait for recognition, position, or

a title. Wherever you are, begin to serve. . . . Make your main concern function, not position. Make your priority service, not status."

To illustrate this point, Rev. Cooke noted that both Jesus Christ and Pontius Pilate had a basin of water. But while Pilate washed his hands in it to evade responsibility, Jesus used it to wash His disciples' feet and serve them. Rev. Cooke encouraged the graduates to embrace responsibility and be there for others, just like Jesus. This was the culminating point, presenting the listeners with a choice about the attitude they would carry into their future. He said, "Being Christlike and being an example of godliness is foundational to everything else that you might do in life."

Rev. Cooke sent the former students out as laborers into the harvest field, emphasizing what his own graduation speaker, T.L. Osborne, said 46 years earlier: 'Ministry is pretty simple. Love people and help them.'



RBTC President Kenneth W. Hagin then charged the listeners to run their race effectively. "Be willing to endure. Sometimes things do not come easily, but success is experienced by those who work hard and persevere. Embrace the challenge, knowing that God is your source, strengthener, and help. He will see you through to the end."

He advised the students to find their ministry wherever God has called them—whether in an office, working on a car, or elsewhere. Afterward, Rev. Kenneth W. and Lynette Hagin passed out relay batons. Each graduating class received a red, blue, or black baton. On each baton, the following words are engraved:

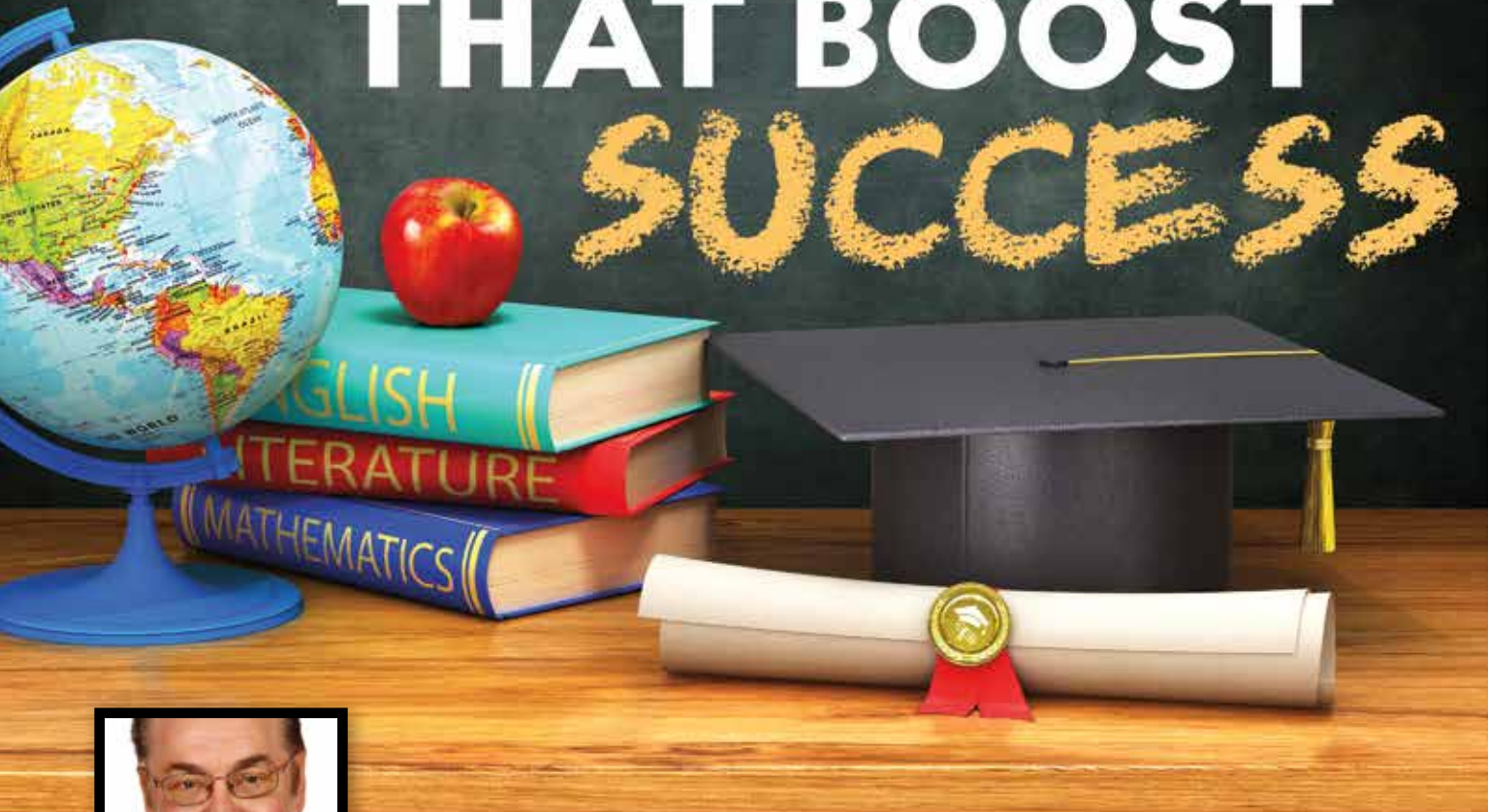
"I commit today to carry the baton of revival to this generation. I will carry the banner of faith and God's power to a lost and dying world. This is my time to do all God has called me to do."

BACKPACK SUPPLIES THAT BOOST SUCCESS

THIS TIME OF YEAR is exciting for most people. Every new school year brings new experiences. You get to explore new subjects and play sports. It also brings back memories of friends you haven't seen all summer. And as school starts, teachers and administrators send out a supply list to students and parents.

I'm going to give you three supplies that are not on any school list. Take them with you if you're a student, but adults can also use them at work or in whatever they do. In fact, anyone can benefit from these supplies throughout life.

1. TAKE GOD WITH YOU EVERY DAY.

God never leaves us. He said He wouldn't: *"I will never leave you nor forsake you"* (Heb. 13:5 NKJV). But sometimes, we leave Him. We forget about Him, or we ignore Him. God is not just for Sunday and Wednesday at church. You need Him all the time.

How do you take God with you wherever you go? By living by the standards of the Word of God. Do what He has said to do in His Word. Don't cheat. Don't do mean things. Don't bully others. Don't say wrong things. That's one way you take God with you. You take Him with you when you know what the Bible says.

Then you act on what it says.

PSALM 119:1-6 (MSG)

- 1 You're blessed when you stay on course, walking steadily on the road revealed by God.
- 2 You're blessed when you follow his directions, doing your best to find him.
- 3 That's right—you don't go off on your own; you walk straight along the road he set.
- 4 You, God, prescribed the right way to live; now you expect us to live it.
- 5 Oh, that my steps might be steady, keeping the course you set;
- 6 Then I'd never have any regrets in comparing my life with your counsel.

If you take God with you, you won't have any regrets. If you want to be successful, you need to let God be with you 24 hours a day.

2. CHOOSE GODLY FRIENDS.

It's very important to choose the right kind of friends because they influence you. They affect the way you talk and what you do or don't do. If you spend time

around people who do wrong, you'll eventually do the same.

One of the lies the enemy tells you is that you can hang around people who do bad things and it won't affect you. That's not true. First Corinthians 15:33 says, *"Do not be misled: 'Bad company corrupts good character'"* (NIV).

What are godly friends? They are the people who encourage you to do the right things (see Psalm 1:1–6). You need to consistently be around those who are godly, like you. That doesn't mean you shouldn't talk to people who are not Christians. Be friendly and invite them to church. Learn to listen to the Holy Spirit on the inside of you. He'll help you know who to spend time with.

Show me your friends, your squad, those you hang around with, and I'll show you your future. I want to encourage you, because this is critical. If you're going to be a success in life or at school, keep company with godly friends.

3. DEVELOP GRIT.

Grit is defined as a personality trait in which an individual demonstrates passion and perseverance toward a goal despite significant obstacles and distractions. I call it a stick-to-it attitude.

This attitude got me on a lot of sports teams in school because I wasn't always as talented as the next guy. Thank God, I could run! I was fast. I kept working hard to achieve my goals, never quitting, never giving up. No matter what, I don't quit!

You need grit to get through school and college, and you'll need it to get through life. You've got to persevere through every obstacle that comes your way. A recent study shows that a person's level of grit is the strongest predictor of what they will achieve.

You will face tough times in life. Jesus tells us in John 16:33, *"I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart,*

because I have overcome the world" (NLT). Also, First John 4:4 says, *"Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world."*

You have to have the determination not to give up. I remember when I was in the Army at Fort Gordon, Georgia, in signal school. It was May first, and they were celebrating May Day big time. We had a track meet, and I signed up.

The last event was the 220-yard sprint. That was my event in high school, but the Army administrators had changed it. Instead of running on the curve, the racers ran on the straightaway. We lined up and took off. I'm a slow starter, so I fell behind. They told me later that our track coach had left and gone to his car because he thought we were going to lose.

But I don't quit! I dug in. I gritted my teeth and started passing guys. Finally, there was only one guy ahead of me with about 25 yards to go. I saw his back muscles begin to tighten up, and I thought, "You're dead meat, buddy! I'm just now getting started good!" I blew past him like he was standing still. And I won the race. That's what grit is. Even when it looks like you're losing, don't give up!

As you go through school this year and throughout life, remember God, godly friends, and grit because all three will help you succeed. ♥

FIVE WAYS TO KEEP GOD FIRST

ONE OF THE greatest gifts my parents gave me was teaching me from a very young age that God should always be first in my life. Long before I understood all the responsibilities and challenges that adulthood would bring, they continually reminded me of a simple but life-changing truth. If you put God first, everything else will eventually find its proper place.

This lesson has stayed with me through every season of life. Jesus emphasized this same principle in Matthew 6. In a chapter where He talked about worries, needs, possessions, and the pressures of everyday living, He gave a clear instruction: *"But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you"* (Matthew 6:33 NKJV). Notice, He didn't say, "seek God whenever you have time." He didn't say seek God after you've handled everything else. He said to seek Him first. The word "first" is important. God does not desire to be merely on our list of priorities. He desires to be at the top of the list.

As we enter the fall season, many of us are returning to normal schedules after the summer months. Vacations are ending, school activities are beginning, and schedules are becoming busier. Calendars fill up quickly. Before long, we can find ourselves rushing from one responsibility to another without ever stopping to evaluate whether our priorities are still aligned with God's priorities.

This is a perfect time to take inventory. Ask yourself a few honest questions: Where is God on my priority list? Has my relationship with Him grown stronger or weaker this year? Am I pursuing success while neglecting spiritual growth? Are there activities that are crowding out what matters most?

Often, our lives don't become unbalanced because of sin. They become unbalanced for many reasons. Good things can become distractions when they take the place that belongs to God. The enemy rarely needs to convince believers to abandon God completely. More often, he simply distracts them. He fills their schedules with so many activities, commitments, and concerns that God slowly moves from first place to a lower spot on the list.

Yet Jesus reminds us that when we seek God first, everything else begins to come into proper perspective. That doesn't mean that every problem disappears. It means that when God occupies His rightful place in our lives, He helps us navigate every challenge with His wisdom, peace, and direction. When God is our priority, we become more sensitive to His voice and quicker to recognize His instructions. He desires to help us with every issue we face, but too often we place Him at the bottom of our list. Have you ever heard someone say, "Well, I tried everything I knew to do, and finally I had to ask God for help"? While that statement may sound sincere, it reveals a common mistake. God was never meant to be our last resort; He is meant to be our first response.

So how do we reprioritize our lives? First, make time with God non-negotiable. Schedule prayer, Bible reading, and worship just as intentionally as you schedule appointments and meetings. What gets scheduled gets done. Second, evaluate your commitments. Not every opportunity is an assignment from God. Some activities may need to be reduced, delegated, or eliminated altogether. If something consistently pulls you away from your relationship with God, it deserves careful evaluation.

Third, put God's Kingdom first in your decisions. Before making plans, ask, "How does this affect my walk with God? Does this help me fulfill His purpose for my life?" Kingdom-minded people view every decision through a spiritual lens.

Fourth, reconnect with God's house through church attendance, fellowship, and serving with other believers. We were never meant to follow Christ in isolation. Fifth, regularly reassess. Priorities drift over time. Make it a habit to periodically examine your schedule, your focus, and your heart.

Life moves quickly. Demands are endless. Distractions are everywhere. But the principle Jesus taught remains as true today as it was when He first spoke it. Seek first! Not second, when it's convenient. Not after everything else is finished. Seek first!

As we move into this fall season, let's make a fresh commitment to place God where He belongs—at the center of our lives and at the top of our priorities. When we do, we discover again what many of us learned years ago: When God is first, everything else has a way of falling into place.

May this season be a time of renewed focus, renewed balance, and renewed pursuit of the One who is worthy of first place in every area of our lives. ♥

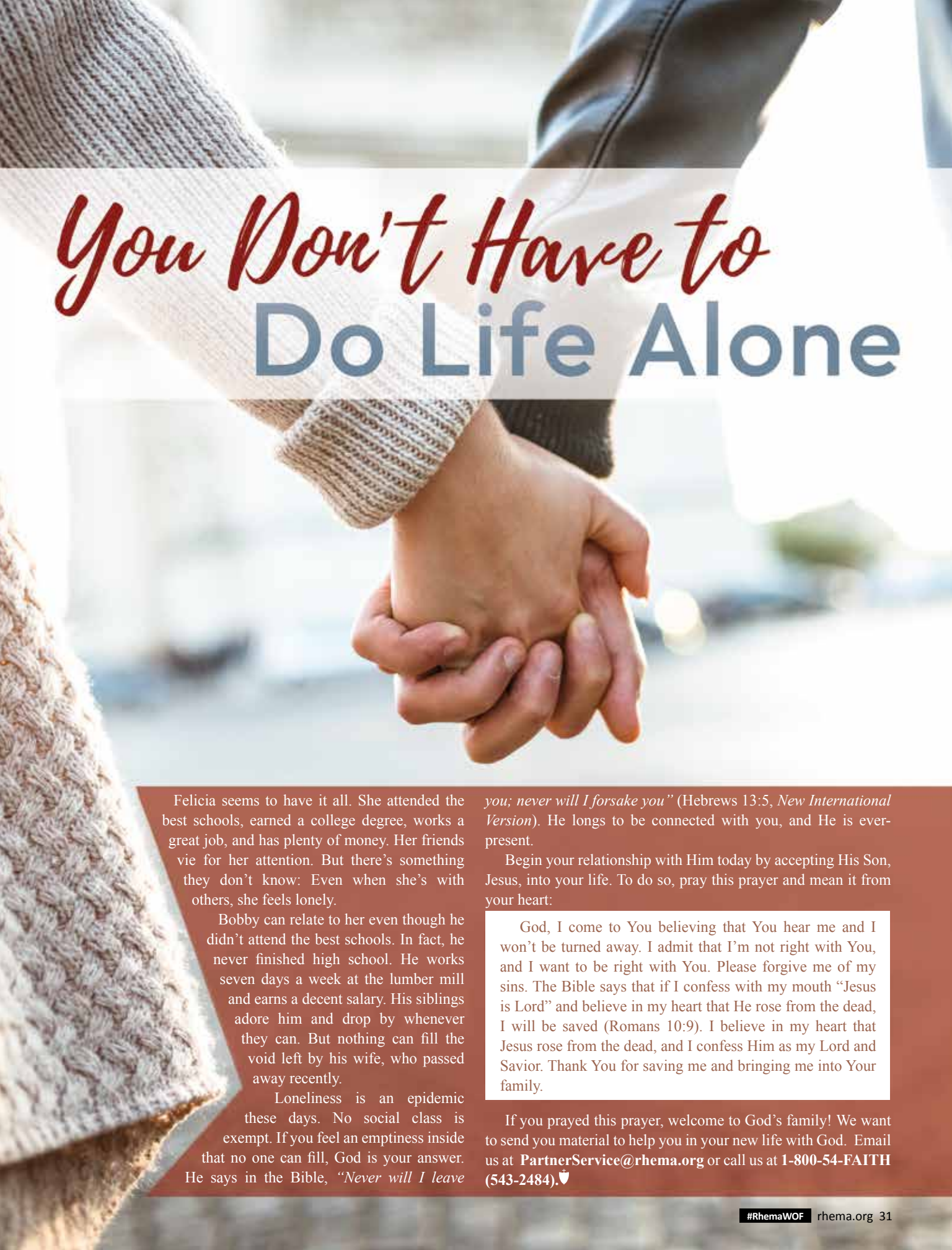
